# What Impact Can *You* Have Here?

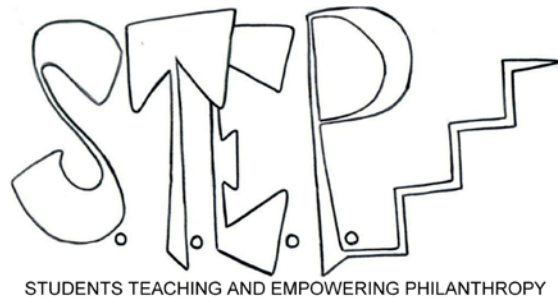
Join S.T.E.P. (Students Teaching & Empowering Philanthropy) to find out!

(Students Teaching & Empowering Philanthropy) is a program in Marshalltown run by youth for the purpose of nurturing philanthropy in youth, developing leaders and allowing youth to identify new community opportunities or expand on existing ones.

This year-long program, sponsored by the Martha-Ellen Tye Foundation and Community Foundation of Marshall County, empowers and challenges high school students to address, identify and seek solutions to community needs. The 2018 program culminates with the students awarding \$10,000 from the Youth Philanthropy Funds of the Martha-Ellen Tye Foundation & Community Foundation of Marshall County to non-profit agencies in Marshall County.
