Making the Most of the CEFP

As you prepare grant your 2023 County Endowment Fund Program dollars, there is no better time to review your policies and practices. Please reference this *Maximizing Your_CEFP_Dollars* resource. The document also references our *Guide to Effective Grantmaking*. As you navigate the allocation process, please do not hesitate to reach out and let us know how we can be helpful.

Please remember, it is important to THANK legislators for this investment. Every press release should mention where these dollars come from. You may use this sample <u>press release</u> to announcing the receipt of the funding and/or your grant distributions.

We also encourage you to consider raising funds for a disaster recovery fund for your county. Those that raise \$1,500 or more are eligible for a \$500 match through the DRF Matching Grants. While you can't use your CEFP grantmaking dollars for this match, your CEFP endowment payout dollars can count toward eligibility.

Disaster Recovery Fund Challenge Grant

The <u>Disaster Recovery Fund Challenge Grant Program</u> application deadline has been extended to November 15. The ICoF team continues to monitor and notify CFs when the Governor declares a state of emergency in their county.
