Idea Implementation Grants Available

Community foundations that participated in the Connect Community Foundations Conference and/or Virtual Series sessions in 2023 are eligible to apply for an Idea Implementation Grant. Requests can range from \$250-\$2,500 to support the foundation's efforts to implement an idea cultivated, developed or re-energized during a Connect session. The application process is competitive; all requests may not receive funding. Idea Implementation Grant Applications are **due November 15.**

Here is a quick list (not comprehensive) of some ideas you might consider for an Idea Implementation grant:

- Become a 21/64 certified advisor or purchase 21/64 tools for your work;
- Host a professional advisor seminar;
- Host informal gatherings at board members' homes to introduce your CF to prospective donors;
- Audit your grantmaking process, then integrate trust-based practices; or
- Host a rural leadership summit.

Public Policy Update

Federal: On October 4 the ICoF joined thousands of sector leaders and advocates in a Philanthropy Day of Action in support of the Charitable Act

(<u>H.R. 3435/S. 566</u>). We contacted each of our Congressional offices asking for their support of the legislation, which would incentivize millions of Americans to give and support their communities by restoring the non-itemizer charitable deduction. A new Politico article featured new polling data from Independent Sector showing broad bipartisan support for robust tax incentives for charitable giving. The data found that 87% of American voters support restoring the universal charitable deduction permanently for all taxpayers, including 51% of voters who strongly support this giving incentive.
